- HPC22/4/02** To receive apologies for absence
Apologies were received from Councillors Martin Deakin, Janet Griffith and Richard McCarthy
- HPC22/4/03** To receive declarations of Members' interests
Councillors Blake, Davis, Edgar and Heler declared an interest in Item 9 relating to a community orchard and Jubilee Tree planting
Councillor Green declared an interest in Item 8 relating to payments
- HPC22/4/04** Public Participation
There were no questions or comments submitted by members of the public
Councillor Melissa Mews joined the meeting at this point
- HPC22/4/05** To confirm the minutes of the meeting held on 6th June 2022
The minutes were approved
- HPC22/4/06** To confirm the minutes of the meeting held on 4th July 2022

- HPC22/4/07** To review the Council's year to date finances
The Council's year to date finances were reviewed and noted
- HPC22/4/08** To consider matters related to Council investments
It was **resolved** to transfer £50,000 in to the Councils investment account
- HPC22/4/09** To consider the approval of payments
It was **resolved** to approve payments totalling:-
 - Net: £54,805.32
 - Gross: £54,933.75
- HPC22/4/10** To consider matters related to a community orchard and Jubilee tree planting
Councillors Davis and Edgar outlined the project relating to a proposed community orchard at The Dingle and arrangements for planting trees throughout the Parish to mark the Queen's Platinum Jubilee
It was **resolved** to allocate £2,500 from the Platinum Jubilee budget towards the community orchard and tree planting

- HPC22/4/12** To consider matters related to funding 20mph speed repeaters on Waterloo Road
It was **resolved** to purchase 20mph speed repeaters to be located on Waterloo Road
- HPC22/4/13** To consider matters related to streetlighting

- HPC22/4/14** To consider matters related to the Neighbourhood Plan
This item was deferred to a future meeting pending the completion of the report from Cheshire Wildlife Trust
- HPC22/4/15** To consider matters related to the purchase of safety signage for the Gutterscroft Centre
It was **resolved** to allocate £1,000 towards safety signage for the Gutterscroft Centre
- HPC22/4/16** To consider matters related to the purchase of new signage for the Gutterscroft Playing Field
It was **resolved** to allocate £2,000 towards new signage for the Gutterscroft Playing Field
- HPC22/4/17** To consider matters related to the purchase of a mobile phone and an associated contract
It was **resolved** to purchase a mobile phone and an associated contract
To consider receive an update from the Cheshire East Councillors covering the Parish
Councillor Edgar provided an update which included:-
- A complaint has been escalated relating to the breach of planning conditions on the Bovis estate which includes noise, disregard for residents and working on Sundays. Planning enforcement have the matter in hand

It was **resolved** to hold a Planning Committee meeting to discuss the forthcoming planning application related to Phase 3 of the Pool Lane development off Crewe Road, Winterley
- HPC22/4/19** To consider matters related to Oakhanger Ward
Councillor Bushill raised concerns relating to recent accidents in the village and the state of vegetation and overhanging trees in the area
- HPC22/4/20** To consider matters related to Haslington Ward
Councillor Mews raised a question relating to the replacement of fencing at the Gutterscroft Playing Field. Councillor Blake is liaising with the contractor to have it replaced
Councillor Edwards reached out to local residents and concerns had been raised relating to parking and speeding throughout the parish
Councillor Davis raised concerns relating to the condition of the car park at the skate park alongside the overgrown vegetation in and around the car park area
Councillor Hovey raised concerns relating to the footpath to the skate park
Councillor Hovey also discussed the recent proposal to expand Wheelock Primary School
